Dear Parents/Guardians,

Thank you for selecting Assumption School as your choice for educating your child. Because the tuition rate varies for parishioners and non-parishioners, it is necessary for your parishioner status to be verified. Keep in mind that the definition of a practicing parishioner includes the following:

- 1) You are registered as a member of the parish by means of the parish census on file in the parish office.
- 2) You are an active member of the parish, sharing weekly in its worship, ministry, and community life.
- 3) You abide by the parishioner requirements as determined by each parish.
- 4) The Assumption Parish Council will be responsible for reviewing Assumption parishioner status requests. All Assumption parishioners must turn this form into the school main office. Families not belonging to Assumption parish must have their request signed by the pastor of their parish.

Kindly have your pastor sign below and return with form with your registration packet. Please note, if your pastor does not agree to pay the \$250 subsidy you will be responsible for the non-parishioner rate.
